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Critical incident (CI) writing in ePortfolios is introduced as a means for student-teachers to record conflicts experienced and what was learned from them. ### **Contributions of assessment-related critical incidents to ...**

Critical incidents are incidents that people remember as being significant for reasons personal to them (Tripp, 1994). They inspire reflection and usually a change in practice attitude, understanding or belief, hence are key to learning. For students, these moments as they apply to the classroom are crucial for learning so it is useful for teachers to know when these occur.

### **Critical Incident Questionnaires - Assessment for Learning ...**

This kind of knowledge is needed in teacher education to prepare future teachers for their profession. The data included narrative interviews with 12 teachers from four urban schools in Finland. Critical incidents were defined as issues or situations in teachers' work that produce ethical reflection and moral emotions.

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
