In the Windows Image pane, expand Components, right-click amd64_Microsoft-Windows-Deployment_ (version), and then select Add Setting to Pass 7 oobeSystem. In the Answer File pane, select Components\7 oobeSystem\amd64_Microsoft-Windows-Deployment_neutral\Reveal.

Because this answer file is cached, when you run the Sysprep command, the system applies settings in the cached answer file. If you use the settings in a different answer file, you can specify a separate Unattend.xml file by using the Sysprep /unattend:<file_name> option.

When you bootup your PC from Windows 7 DVD, setup will begin automatically and will search the root directory of all removable media(which includes your USB disks too) for an answer file called Autounattend.xml. Install Windows AIK on any compatible system (preferably not the system being imaged) and open the Windows System Image Manager on the Start Menu ...

How to create an unattend.xml answer file for Windows 7, 8 ...

Type Windows System Image Manager into the Windows 7 menu search bar and open it. In the bottom left Windows Image panel, right-click and insert the install.wim that is located in the sources subdirectory of the installation disk's root directory. Then right-click the central panel and create a new answer-file.

I have built a desktop box running Windows 7 Professional, created a sysprep.xml file using WSIM from a walkthrough on Microsoft's technet site. I placed the sysprep.xml file in the c:\windows\system32\syspre p directory, and syspreped the machine successfully by running: sysprep /generalize /oobe /shutdown /unattend:sysprep.xml

Right click DiskConfiguration under Microsoft-Windows-Setup in the Answer File pane, then select Insert New Disk: Next, select the new disk in the Answer File pane, and edit its properties. DiskID tells Windows Setup which disk to use to install Windows, where DiskID 0 is the primary hard disk (DiskID 1 = second HDD, and so on).

Any other "free" Windows 7 download you come across online is most certainly illegal, including Windows 7 ISO files obtained via torrents or directly from other websites or servers.
