If you're using the OM-D E-M10 you can use the monotone picture more or the Grainy Film Art Filter to take a photo in black and white (such an easy way to shoot in black and white).

Finally, set the black point for the image. Open up the Levels panel once again and double click on the black eyedrop on the right of the panel. Set the RGB values to 20, 19 and 20 respectively.
