The name Carnegie Hill was first applied at the turn of the century to a small area surrounding Andrew Carnegie's mansion at 91st Street and Fifth Avenue. Today, the residential neighborhood is bounded on the west by Fifth Avenue, on the east by, but not including, Third Avenue, on the south by 86th Street, and on the north by 98th Street between Fifth and Park avenues, and 96th Street between Park and Third Avenues.

The Carnegie Hill Historic District, named for one time resident Andrew Carnegie who was a national figure in the growth of the steel industry, is primarily residential, with row houses, town houses, mansions, and flats on tree-lined streets and apartment buildings on broad avenues. The Hall of Architecture, with its collection of over 140 plaster casts of architectural masterpieces from the past, opened in 1907. At that time, collections of casts were numerous in both Europe and the United States.
