Intellectual disability case management progress in particular are more detailed since these services will likely be in place for the lifetime of the client. Example Case Notes - Department of Labor

Examples might include temporary housing needs, including family shelters (for homeless clients), domestic violence shelters or other safe housing (for clients experiencing domestic violence), drug-or-alcohol-free housing (for clients in recovery), transitional housing (for families who need case-management services while looking for permanent housing), low-income housing (for families with limited income or resources);

Case Note Sample Narratives

The client ' s chief complaint or primary problem can be stated in his or her own words, or a summation can be described. Example A:Elaine R.'s chief complaint is stated as a difficult relationship with her supervisor. Client states the relationship has been difficult for the last 2 months, but seems to be getting worse.

The elements of a quality case management note include the following information: Day x of an expected LOS of y days (for example, " It is day two of a five-day expected LOS. ")
