There is no hierarchy of permanence options; what matters is the welfare and wellbeing of each child, and finding the right home and family for them. Adoption Adoption is probably the most well-known form of permanence in the UK. When a child is adopted, their new parents take on full parental responsibility for their care as their legal guardian.

What is permanence?

The objective of planning for permanence is to ensure that children have a secure, stable and loving family to support them through childhood and beyond, and to give them a sense of security, continuity, commitment, identity and belonging.

Long-term fostering placements made as part of a permanency planning process need to have a distinct status and be formally confirmed. Where a child is in a fostering placement, the child is in a fostering placement.

In most circumstances, children can be reunited with their families, but in some cases children find homes with relatives or adoptive families achieve permanency, child welfare professionals must balance an array of issues, including needs of the child and the family, as well as legal requirements.
