What is a forest? Forests are rich abundant habitats full of trees and shrubs and all kinds of animals. Before people arrived in New Zealand, 80% of the land was covered in dense forest. Now only 24% of land is native forest, or just under 6.5 million hectares. Two of the main types of native forest in New Zealand are beech and podocarp-hardwood.

Temperate Forest Habitat - Kids

The main layers of all forest types are the forest floor, the understory and the canopy. The emergent layer exists in tropical rainforests. Each layer has a different set of plants and animals depending upon the availability of sunlight, moisture and food. Forest floor contains decomposing leaves, animal droppings, and dead trees. Decay on the forest floor forms new soil and provides nutrients to the plants.
