In competitive matches, the umpire is responsible for keeping score. Typically the score is also shown on an electronic scoreboard. During non-competitive padel matches, the player serving is responsible for keeping score and shouting out the current score before every serve.

To keep score in tennis, award a player 15 points the first time they score. If they score a second time, they'll be at 30 points. The third time they score, they'll be at 40 points. If they score a fourth time, they win. Before each serve, call out the score, saying the server's score first and then the other player's score.

You score D10 (double 10), 20 and 5 in your first turn. The total is 20+20+5 = 45. Your starting score = 301. You scored = 45. Points to go = 301 - 45 = 256. Each player has a stick, called a cue, which helps to push the disc along. Before play begins, decide if the score will be 50, 75 or 100. The lower the number, the shorter the game will be. The person with the yellow discs goes first.

If each player wins enough points to get the score to 40-40 (also known as a deuce or 40-all), they enter the "ad phase" of the game. Since every game must be won by two points, one player must score two points in a row. If the server wins the first point after the deuce, the score becomes advantage-in (ad-in). Win or go back to deuce.
