There are gross and net income limits. The gross income limit is equal to 185% of the current Federal Poverty Level and is the amount of income the household has before taxes and deductions. The gross income limit applies to most households. The gross income limit does not apply to households in which at least one person is 60 years of age or older, or receives disability income.

Under federal rules, to be eligible for benefits a household ' s income and resources must meet three tests: Gross monthly income — that is, household income before any of the program ' s deductions are applied — generally must be at or below 130 percent of the poverty line.
