Jacques Lipchitz was a Cubist sculptor. Lipchitz retained highly figurative and legible components in his work leading up to 1915–16, after which naturalist and descriptive elements were muted, dominated by a synthetic style of Crystal Cubism. In 1920 Lipchitz held his first solo exhibition, at Léonce Rosenberg's Galerie L'Effort Moderne in Paris. Fleeing the Nazis he moved to the US and settled in New York City and eventually Hastings-on-Hudson.

The sculpture was originally produced in plaster and that version was on display in Philadelphia in 1952 when Lipchitz' New York studio burned, destroying all his works in progress. The Philadelphia Museum of Art purchased the work at the highest price it had paid for a work by a living sculptor at that time.

of the subject, of its humanity. In 1917–18 he abandoned the austere purity that had characterized much of his recent work and created clearly legible Cubist subjects: bathers, musicians, harlequins, and still-lives.

Lipchitz commissioned Modigliani to paint this portrait on the occasion of his marriage to the Russian poet Berthe Kitrosser, as a way of helping his troubled friend financially. The double portrait is one of only three in the artist's oeuvre and, according to Lipchitz, took two days to paint.

Lipchitz completed his "Prometheus" for the 1937 Paris World Exposition and was awarded a gold medal for the sculpture. When German troops occupied Paris in 1940, Lipchitz fled to Toulouse, from where he soon left France for good and went to the US, where he settled in New York.

This object is a three-dimensional study in bronze produced by American artist Jacques Lipchitz in 1953 as a preparatory work for a much larger public sculpture entitled The Spirit of Enterprise. It takes the form of a semi-abstract figure of a man shown in the act of walking, his right leg thrust forward in a large and powerful stride.

Lipchitz dies in Italy in May 1973. He bequeaths 300 of his sculptures to the Jerusalem Museum of Art, where they remain in the Lipchitz Pavilion. In 1978, Hadassah Hospital unveils his "Tree of Life," a 37-foot-tall, bronze sculpture representing the Jewish patriarchs, the burning bush and the two tablets of the law.

The Cubist sculptures and bas-reliefs of Lipchitz's first period of maturity, from 1914 to 1925, show but few of the faults of his recent work. They seldom fail of unity, even if it is at the price of a kind of constriction due to adherence to a narrow repertory of forms literally translated from the painted Cubism of Picasso and Gris.

On the Horizon: The Sculpture of Jacques Lipchitz ...

The first treatment was a small clay sketch of 1925. Lipchitz returned to the theme in 1943, and in 1946 began the series of drawings, clay studies, and finished sculptures that led directly to the final version of Sacrifice III. The theme of ritual sacrifice was catalyzed by the fate of the Jews during World War II.
