The Soviets (the term itself is Russian for 'council') were groups of critical importance in 1917. The Soviets were committees of representatives, elected by workers, soldiers and sailors - so by the nature of their membership they were militant, protective of working-class interests and hostile to both tsarist and bourgeois governments.

A second pathology is the yawning gap between Washington's expectations about Russia's post-Soviet political development and Russian realities, which have refused to conform to those expectations.
