Patrick Henry (1736–99) (1775) Born in 1736, died in 1799; admitted to the Bar in 1760; entered the Virginia House of Burgesses in 1765; acted with Thomas Jefferson in promoting intercourse between the Colonies in 1773; Member of the First Continental Congress in 1774; elected Governor of Virginia in 1776 and 1784; Member of the Convention which ratified the Constitution in 1788, acting with the antifederalists.
