The First Epistle to the Thessalonians, commonly referred to as First Thessalonians or 1 Thessalonians, is a Pauline epistle of the New Testament of the Christian Bible. The epistle is attributed to Paul the Apostle, and is addressed to the church in Thessalonica, in modern-day Greece. It is likely the first of Paul's letters, probably written by the end of AD 52. However, some scholars believe the Epistle to Galatians may have been written by AD 48.

With regard to past dimensions of salvation, Paul spoke of God's choice or election of the Thessalonians. Paul said that God "chose" the Thessalonians, meaning that before the Thessalonians came to faith through Paul's preaching of the gospel, God had already decided that he loved the Thessalonians and was going to save them.

Paul's First Letter to the Thessalonians Midway through the First Letter to the Thessalonians, Paul inserts a prayer which commentators recognise as a neat summary of the message he wanted to get across: Now may our God and Father himself and our Lord Jesus direct our way to you.

Chapter 3 is where he mentions that he sent Timothy "to strengthen and encourage you concerning your faith". (1 Thessalonians 3:2) When you read 1 Timothy and 2 Timothy, you see the type of work that Paul expected of Timothy. Paul seems to expect Timothy to be a disciplinarian who resolves problems.

Paul wrote his first letter to the Thessalonian church from the city of Corinth around AD 51, just a few months after having preached in Thessalonica on his second missionary journey. Upon leaving Thessalonica under duress, Paul, Silas, and Timothy traveled to Athens by way of Berea.

First Thessalonians, then, was written during the eighteen months Paul stayed at Corinth, i.e. in the year 48 or 49, according to the chronology of Harnack, "Chronologie der althristlichen Litteratur" (Leipzig, 1897), I, 717; in the year 53 or 54 according to the commonly received scheme of Pauline chronology.
