Postoperative care. Post operative note and orders. The patient should be discharged to the ward with comprehensive orders for the following:

- Vital signs
- Pain control
- Rate and type of intravenous fluid
- Urine and gastrointestinal fluid output
- Other medications
- Laboratory investigations

The patient's progress should be monitored and should include at least:

- A comment on

Postoperative care is the management of a patient after surgery. This includes care given during the immediate postoperative period, both in the operating room and postanesthesia care unit (PACU), as well as during the days following surgery.

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Postoperative Care of the Surgical Patient. The patient's immediate recovery period is managed in a postanesthesia care unit (PACU), which is located adjacent to the operating room (OR). This location minimizes transportation of the patient immediately after surgery and provides ready access to anesthesia and OR personnel.
