Criteria to become a registered sanitarian includes diploma from an approved four-year high school or the equivalent and completion of a four-year degree from a college or university with a minor or 24 semester hours in environmental health, biological science or physical science. An applicant is required to pass a written examination in subjects specified by the Cabinet.

A license is required for Health Officers or Registered Environmental Health Specialists employed by local health departments. The Licensure of Persons for Public Health Positions sets forth the license standards. New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH) licenses candidates who meet requirements for education, training and experience.
