Eigg, which measures just 5 by 3 miles, is by far the most vibrant, populous and welcoming of the Small Isles, with a strong sense of community. There are wonderful views of Muck and Rum from An Sgurr (1292 ft). Smallest and most southerly of the Small Isles, Muck is low-lying, mostly treeless and extremely fertile, and as such shares more characteristics with the likes of Coll and Tiree than its nearest neighbours.

The Inner Hebrides - the Small Isles of Rum, Eigg, Muck and Canna lie 5- 10 miles west of Arisaig. Unlike many groups each Island is distinct and different in geography, agronomy, population and ownership. From Muck in the South, through Eigg with its recognisable Sgurr, and Rum, mountainous and mysterious in the clouds, to Canna in the North, the Islands offer a wonderful variety of scenery, wildlife and lifestyle.

The Small Isles are a small archipelago of islands in the Inner Hebrides, off the west coast of Scotland. They lie south of Skye and north of Mull and Ardnamurchan – the most westerly point of mainland Scotland. The islands form part of the Lochaber area of the Highland council area. Until 1891 Canna, R ù m and Muck were historically part of the shire of Argyll; Eigg was historically part of Inverness-shire. All of the Small Isles were in Inverness-shire between 1891 and 1975, and remain ...

Isle of Rum – Small isles The Small Isles comprise Rum, Eigg, Muck, Canna and Sanday and are accessed via Arisaig on the MV Shearwater (summer only) or from Mallaig by Caledonian MacBrayne (year round). These ferries are passenger ferries only. Visitors are not generally permitted to take vehicles to the islands.

Four are inhabited and have a ferry service: Rum, Eigg, Muck and Canna. There are also numerous tiny uninhabited islets and skerries. 1 Rum is the largest, with its only settlement at Kinloch.

The Caledonian MacBrayne ferry MV Lochnevis sails a circular route around the four "Small Isles"—Eigg, Canna, R ù m and Muck from the fishing port of Mallaig. Arisaig Marine also runs a passenger ferry called the MV Sheerwater from April until late September from Arisaig on the mainland.

Off the west coast of Scotland, south of the Isle of Skye and north of Mull and Ardnamurchan, the islands of Coll and Tiree are the most westerly of the Inner Hebrides and have a reputation as being amongst Scotland's sunniest places. Together with the Small Isles archipelago of Eigg, Rum, Muck and Canna to the north, these Hebridean gems provide a remarkable range and variety of walking. The 36 routes in this book explore these six magical islands's rich histories and thriving wildlife as well as the fine sandy beaches, awe-inspiring cliffs and coves, wild interiors and dramatic mountain ranges which make them so special.

The Small Isles are often called the hidden gems of the Western Isles, providing a walking paradise for those seeking wilderness and solitude, alongside the better-known Rum. Highlights include, on Rum, the towering volcanic peaks of the Rum Cuillin, Kinloch Castle, Kilmory bay; An Sgurr and Cleadale on Eigg; Canna's towering cliffs and rock stacks; the verdant landscape and sparkling shores of Muck; and the white sand bays and flower-carpeted machair of Coll and Tiree. Each island is different and has its own introduction here, with detailed information on geology,

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history and wildlife, as well as local amenities.

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
