DON'T : Use force to get your child into school. Remember that this is a real fear and extreme level of anxiety. Think of your worst fear and someone forcing you to confront it. This method of 'facing your fears' is called "Flooding" and is risky.

School Refusal Support Services - Dont's

School refusal can occur when a young person finds it difficult to attend school because they experience emotional distress, such as anxiety, in doing so. This can present as feeling ill or unhappy in the morning before school with a desire to stay at home.

Understanding school refusal - headspace

School refusal is when a child gets extremely upset at the idea of going to school, or often misses some or all of the school day, and this distress doesn't go away. School refusal can mean that children have trouble going to school or trouble leaving home - they might not go to school at all.
