Example 1: A right triangle has a side length of 10 feet, and a hypotenuse length of 20 feet. Find the other side length. (round to the nearest tenth of a foot) Substitute a = 10 and c = 20 into the Pythagorean Theorem and solve for b. $a^2 + b^2 = c^2$ $(10)^2 + b^2 = (20)^2$ $100 + b^2 = 400$ $b^2 = 300$ $b = \sqrt{300} \approx 17.3$ feet.

To SOLVE A TRIANGLE means to know all three sides and all three angles. When we know the ratios of the sides, we use the method of similar figures. Use SOHCAHTOA and set up a ratio such as $\sin(16) = 14/x$. (From here solve for X). By the way, you could also use cosine. Method 2. SOHCAHTOA: Find the sides of a right triangle

These are the four steps we need to follow: Step 1 Find which two sides we know – out of Opposite, Adjacent and Hypotenuse. Step 2 Use SOHCAHTOA to decide which one of Sine, Cosine or Tangent to use in this question. Step 3 For Sine calculate Opposite/Hypotenuse, for Cosine calculate ...

Finding an Angle in a Right Angled Triangle - MATH

Examples include: 3, 4, 5; 5, 12, 13; 8, 15, 17, etc. Area and perimeter of a right triangle are calculated in the same way as any other triangle. The perimeter is the sum of the three sides of the triangle and the area can be determined using the following equation: $A = \frac{1}{2} ab = \frac{1}{2} ab$.
