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The most universal rule to start an essay with a quote - is to introduce the quote to your essay by mentioning the author's name, e.g. "Franklin Roosevelt once said...". In this case put quotation marks around the quote as well as include any needed punctuation within these quotation marks.

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Simple but useful tips how to start an essay with a quote

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Starting an essay with a quote is wasted words, and it's NEVER – yes that's right NEVER – appropriate to the darned essay question. Apparently we haven't stated it directly this season. We're starting to think that we should just regurgitate all of last year's posts – “On this day in a prior year we said...” – instead of bothering to write anything new.

Don't start an essay with a quote. Just - don't!

Therefore, the question should be, can I start a sentence or paper with a quote? The answer is yes, but you would need a good reason to do this. If you have a good reason, then there is no problem

Main Body is the place you're meant to state a quote or two, depending on the length of a paper. A standard 5-paragraph essay will imply you to use 2-3 quotes in the main body. More quotes aren't necessary for such a short assignment. Two quotes in the main body will do just fine.
