## **Teaching Phonics To First Grade**

Medial sounds, the sound in the middle of the word, can help teach phonics to first graders by showing how two separate sounds string together to make a different sound. When kids hear words like “cap”, “man”, “and” “hand” they can recognize the medial “a” sound. Hearing words that end the same, like “map,” “tap,” “nap,” and so on, also helps them understand how the different sounds within a word come together to make unique sounds specific to that word.

Principle #1: There is no one best way to teach phonics. But however you teach it, phonics instruction should be systematic and explicit. Systematic means that we progress through a specific scope and sequence. For example, if students are ready to learn short vowel word families, we don't teach miscellaneous word families as they appear in our shared reading stories.
