For 28 years, Húrin watched the curse destroy his children. His daughter, Niënor, was born shortly after his capture and was trapped in the doom of Túrin. Their actions also led to the destruction of Nargothrond, one of the last kingdoms of the Noldor. Now only Gondolin remained.
