The Venetus A (Marciana 454 = 822) The manuscript Marcianus Graecus Z. 454 (= 822), known to Homeric scholars as the Venetus A, is the oldest complete text of the Iliad in existence. It was acquired by the Greek Cardinal Basileus Bessarion in the 15th century CE and donated together with his entire collection of Greek manuscripts to the Republic of Venice, thereby forming the Marciana library 's initial collection.
